A weekly report presenting additional hours booked by NHS trusts in England due to COVID-19, nationally and by region.

- This week saw a significant rise of nearly 20%, and overall hours booked break 140k, for only the second time since the first lockdown.
- COVID-19 bookings rose this week by just under 5%.
- London increased over 108%, its largest week booked since the first lockdown.
- Accident & Emergency was the largest non COVID-19 speciality, seeing an increase of 32%.
- Haematology saw a significant increase, up nearly 300%.
- North West had the largest proportion of COVID-19 bookings this week which represented 32% of all COVID-19 hours booked nationally.
- General Medicine was the most popular speciality booked for COVID-19.


