


Changing the global health economy

A weekly report presenting additional hours booked by NHS trusts in England due to COVID-19, nationally and by region.

- The 4 week rolling average continues to decrease, with average hours falling from 121k to 117k.
- COVID-19 related bookings increased slightly to just over 21.5k hours on average.
- All regions, apart from the South West and North East & Yorkshire, saw an increase in the number of hours booked this week.
- The Midlands saw a significant increase in the number of hours booked due to COVID-19, jumping from 7,760 to 12,727.
- General Medicine and Chemical Pathology had the highest number of COVID-19 hours this week. 55% of all COVID-19 hours were booked in these two specialties.
- The highest number of non COVID-19 hours were booked in Psychiatry Services.
