


Changing the global health economy

A weekly report presenting additional hours booked by NHS trusts in England due to COVID-19, nationally and by region.


- The overall 4 week rolling average decreased slightly this week, with average total hours booked falling from 127k to 124k.
- COVID-19 bookings continue to gradually trend upwards on average.
- Nationally, there was a decrease in the number of hours booked, falling 22% to 108k hours this week.
- Whilst most regions saw a reduction in the number of hours booked compared to last week, the North West saw an increase of 27%.
- COVID-19 hours in this region accounted for over 25% of all hours booked.
- General Medicine was the specialty with the highest number of COVID-19 hours this week.


