


Changing the global health economy

A weekly report presenting additional hours booked by NHS trusts in England due to COVID-19, nationally and by region.

- The overall rolling 4 week average continues its downward trend this week, however COVID-19 bookings still accounted for 16% of all bookings.
- Hours booked are now similar to those at the start of the first lockdown in March 2020, with COVID-19 bookings dropping below the 20k average.
- London and the South East saw rises of 40% whilst the Midlands saw a drop of nearly 30%.
- Psychiatry services were the highest booked non COVID-19 specialty, rising nearly 60%
- General Medicine continues to be the most booked COVID-19 specialty, accounting for more than 30%.
