


Changing the global health economy

A weekly report presenting additional hours booked by NHS trusts in England due to COVID-19, nationally and by region.

- The four week rolling average continues to rise this week, following an increase of non COVID-19 bookings.
- General Medicine and Psychiatry Services continue to have the highest number of non COVID-19 bookings, accounting for 16% of all hours booked this week.
- There was a 23% reduction in the number of hours booked due to COVID-19 nationally, the lowest level since December.
- COVID-19 bookings accounted for 11.7% of all hours booked, compared to 15.8% the previous week.
- General Medicine, Chemical Pathology and Geriatric Medicine had the highest number of COVID-19 hours this week.


