


Changing the global health economy

A weekly report presenting additional hours booked by NHS trusts in England due to COVID-19, nationally and by region.

- The four week rolling average increased by 6.5% this week to 117k, driven by an increase of 8% in non COVID-19 bookings.
- For COVID-19 bookings, the four week rolling average reduced slightly to 15k.
- All regions saw an increase in non COVID-19 hours, significantly in London, the North West and the South West.
- Psychiatry, General Medicine and Therapy Services had the highest number of non COVID-19 bookings and COVID-19 bookings.
- COVID-19 hours in London were more than 4.5 times higher this week, the highest number since June 2020.


