


Changing the global health economy

A weekly report presenting additional hours booked by NHS trusts in England due to COVID-19, nationally and by region.

- The four week rolling average for non COVID-19 bookings increased by 2.9% this week to 119k.
- The four week rolling average for COVID-19 bookings remained static at 15k.
- Nationally, there was a slight decrease in the number of non COVID-19 bookings made compared with the previous week.
- Psychiatry Services and General Medicine continue to be the specialties with the highest number of non COVID-19 hours.
- The overall number of COVID-19 hours fell by 14%, accounting for 10% of all hours booked.
- General Medicine had the highest number of COVID-19 hours this week (40%).


