


Changing the global health economy

A weekly report presenting additional hours booked by NHS trusts in England due to COVID-19, nationally and by region.

- The four week rolling average increased again this week by 2.8%.
- Non COVID-19 bookings increased by 6.4%, whilst COVID-19 bookings fell by 20%.
- Nationally, there was an increase in non COVID-19 bookings week on week. This was driven largely by the South West, which doubled to 24k.
- General Medicine and Psychiatry Services had the highest number of non COVID-19 hours this week.
- Nationally, COVID-19 hours accounted for 5.65% of all hours booked.
- General Medicine remains the specialty with the highest number of COVID-19 hours.


