


Changing the global health economy

A weekly report presenting additional hours booked by NHS trusts in England due to COVID-19, nationally and by region.

- The four week rolling average reduced this week from 115k hours to 112k, following a reduction in both COVID-19 and non COVID-19 hours.
- Nationally, there was a reduction of 10k (10.8%) in non COVID-19 hours this week compared to last week.
- Psychiatry and General Medicine were the specialties with the highest number of non COVID-19 hours this
 week.
- There was a significant reduction in the number of COVID-19 hours in the Midlands, falling by 56% week on week.
- Hours booked in General Medicine and Chemical Pathology accounted for 41% of all COVID-19 hours.
