


Changing the global health economy

A weekly report presenting additional hours booked by NHS trusts in England due to COVID-19, nationally and by region.

- The four week rolling average decreased for the first time since March to 114k.
- Nationally, the number of hours booked fell this week from 119k to 97k.
- Overall, the number of hours booked due to COVID-19 fell by 58% week on week and accounted for 8.85% of all hours booked.
- Non COVID-19 hours decreased by 10%.
- All regions saw a reduction in non COVID-19 hours with the exception of London.
- Psychiatry Services had the highest number of non COVID-19 bookings.
- General Medicine, Accident & Emergency and Trauma and Orthopaedics had the highest number of COVID-19 hours this week, accounting for 66%.
